



## INCOME ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible for emergency food assistance if you are currently participating in: SNAP Program, TANF, SSI, LIHEAP and State General Assistance or if your income is equal to or below:

Eligibility to meet these guidelines is self-declared. Agencies providing food assistance may ask for proof of address to ensure clients live in the region they serve. No address is required if you are homeless.

Supplemental food boxes provide food once a month to those in need. \*\*Emergency food is made available to persons in emergency need based on current supplies.
