Street-to-Home Kits

YCAP operates several housing programs serving a wide variety of individuals and families, including veterans, those fleeing domestic violence, and those working with Yamhill County Mental Health.

Purpose:

As individuals and families enter YCAP housing programs from the streets or from a shelter program, they often lack the basic household supplies necessary to have a fresh start in their new apartment. The Street-to-Home Kit project allows community members to provide those basic items that will assist each household in making a smooth transition into housing. The value of each kit counts as match for our Federal and State funds.

A complete Kit includes:

Bedding for a twin or double bed (sheets and comforter)
Pillow
Hangers
Bath Towels (4)
Hand towels (4)
Wash cloths (4)
Skillet
Can opener
Cleaning supplies (sponges, paper towels, dish soap, detergent)
Toilet paper
Light bulbs
\$20 Walmart giftcard

Note: All items in Kit should be purchased new. We will also accept used toasters and coffee pots in good condition on an as need basis.
